DAY 1

ARRIVAL @ HCMC

We will visit the Notre Dame Cathedral, the Central Post Office, the Opera House and have your photograph taken with the Uncle Ho statue in front of the People's Committee Building.*

DAY 2

CU CHI TUNNELS-CHINATOWN

Today, we make our way to the Cu Chi Tunnels, a 250km underground network of tunnels dug by the Vietnamese and used by the Viet Cong during both the French-Indochina War (1946-1954) and the Vietnam War (1955-1975).

After lunch, we take a tour of the bustling Chinatown dominated by Vietnamese Chinese. We will visit Binh Tay Market, the biggest wholesale market in Saigon. Next stop - the new An Dong Plaza and the old An Dong Market - for you to compare how time has changed the landscape. Local products and handicraft are a good buy at the old An Dong Market. Thien Hoa Pagoda is our next location. Dedicated to the Goddess of the Sea, this pagoda is popular with seafarers giving thanks Free time after dinner. and prayers for their safe voyages from China to Vietnam. The huge coils of incense make for a wonderful photo opportunity.

DAY₃

MEKONG DAY TRIP

Today we move out of the city into the local suburbs and padi fields. We begin our tour of the Mekong Delta with a ride on a motorized boat to the Cai Be Floating Market.

We land at An Binh island, located between Cai Be and Vinh Long, to view the local industries of poprice (local version of popcorn) and rice paper making, and coconut candy workshop.


Lunch is followed by a short walk around the island. We will paddle along the small canals back to our big boat and set off for the brick and pottery factory at Vinh Long. As we head back to the city, think about how the My Thuan Bridge has helped to reduce the travelling time to Vinh Long. There will be a short stop at Vinh Trang Temple to understand the religion at the Mekong Delta.

We embark on one of Singapore's most loved hobbies today. It's shopping day as we explore the various shopping centres in town - from the traditional to the modern.
